- Attend each of the Evening Sessions from 6pm to 8:30 p.m. Dates to be confirmed during Orientation Session
- Engage fully in the Class Project - planning, coordinating, and managing the Dinuba Cinco de Mayo Celebration May 3-5, 2018. Requires class members to begin working on planning for the event several months before the celebration and a presentation of Event Summary & Financial Report to the Dinuba City Council June 11 will need to be scheduled. Class members are also encouraged to assist the Cinco de Mayo Pageant – typically the Saturday before the Cinco de Mayo Event, and usually from 6-7pm
- Provide own transportation for all LNTC activities, sessions, meetings, etc. (exception: 2-day Sacramento trip. Transportation will be provided and related expense is covered through tuition)

**There is a 100% attendance policy.** Any unexcused absence may result in forfeiture of tuition and removal from the program. In the case of illness or family emergency that necessitates missing a day or evening session, you will be responsible for making up that time as specified by the LNTC facilitator.

### **Tuition**

Tuition for the Leadership Northern Tulare County Program is \$850 and is non-refundable. Payment of tuition must be made at the time of receipt of the Letter of Acceptance from the Steering Committee and paid in full no later than October 1, 2018. A limited number of partial scholarships may be available.

Tuition covers all expenses for books and materials. Tuition also covers all expenses for the Welcome Reception, 2-day Team Building Retreat, 2-day Sacramento Trip, 2-day Culminating Retreat and Graduation Ceremony. *Please note: transportation is only included for the 2-day Sacramento Trip.*
