Petty Theft / Shoplifting:

- Petty theft is defined as any unlawful taking of property from another that does not exceed \$950.00
 - When petty theft occurs, Dinuba Police will respond and investigate the theft. If there is a suspect that was observed in the theft the Dinuba Police Department will have the owner sign one of the two following forms
 - 837 PC – Private Person’s Arrest Form
 - Non-Prosecution Form

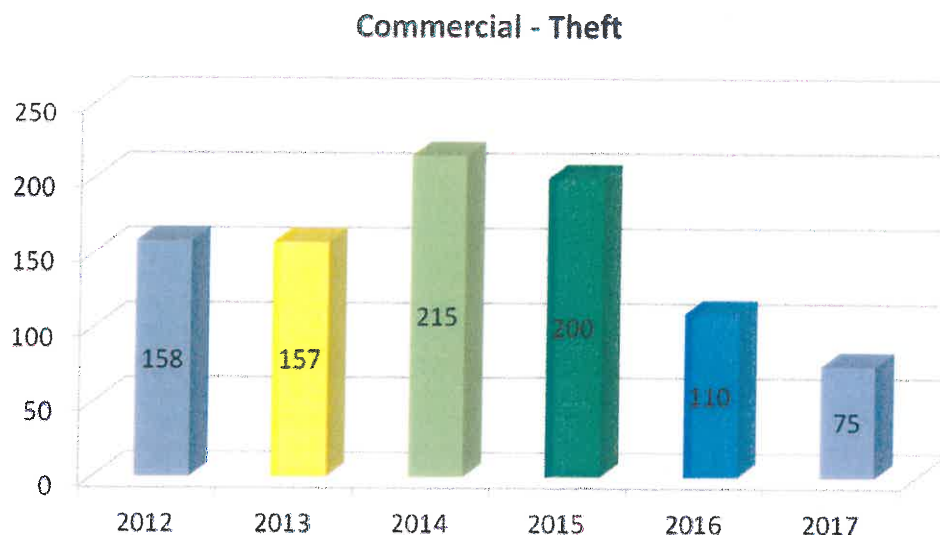
Grand Theft -Larceny

- Grand Theft occurs when property is taken in anything in value over \$950.00.
 - When Grand Theft occurs Dinuba Police Officers will take a felony case report and most likely be forward to the Investigations Unit.
 - Investigations will review the case and based on the leads and suspect information; Investigations will resume the investigation.

- Video Surveillance
- Witness(es)
- Identification of Suspect(s) (Photo Line-Up)
- Dollar Amount / Itemized Receipt

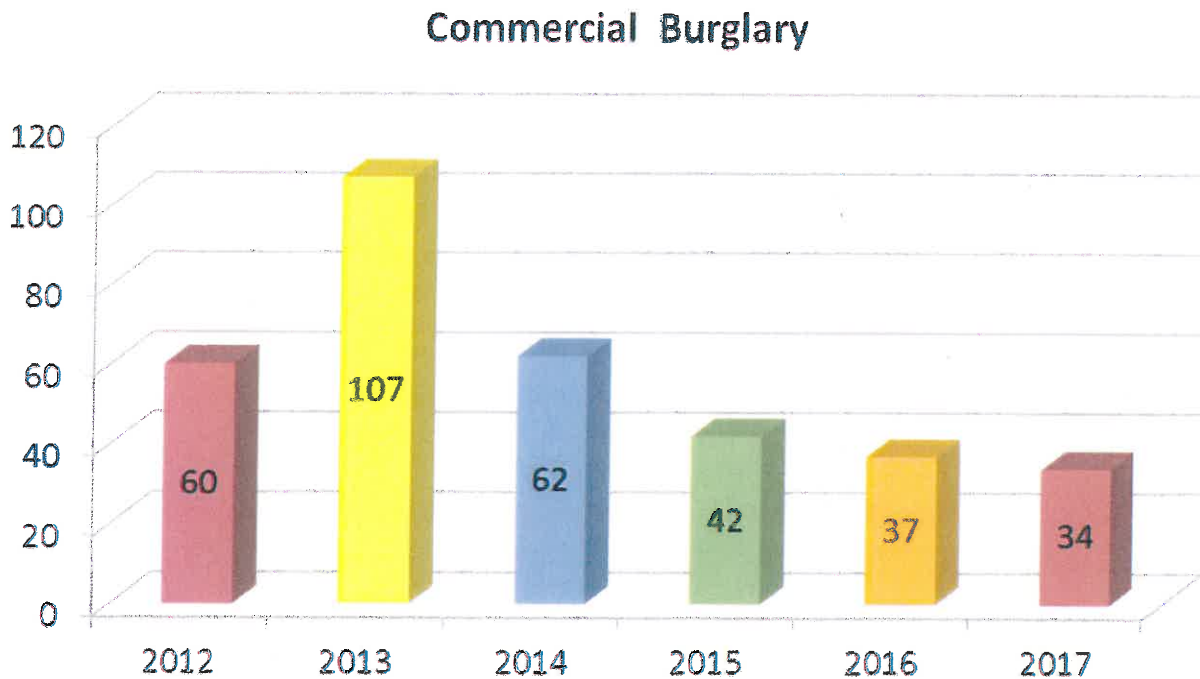
THEFT STATISTICS



COMMERCIAL BURGLARY:

- Anyone who enters a building and/or has planned to commit theft from a secured or unsecured building (including commercial businesses).
- What does this mean to you?
 - If a subject enters a commercial business and has no money or means of paying for the goods (Product) and decides to take the product without paying; the subject can be charged with commercial burglary depending on other factors.
 - Bad Check/ Insufficient Funds
 - Fictitious Money
 - Scam

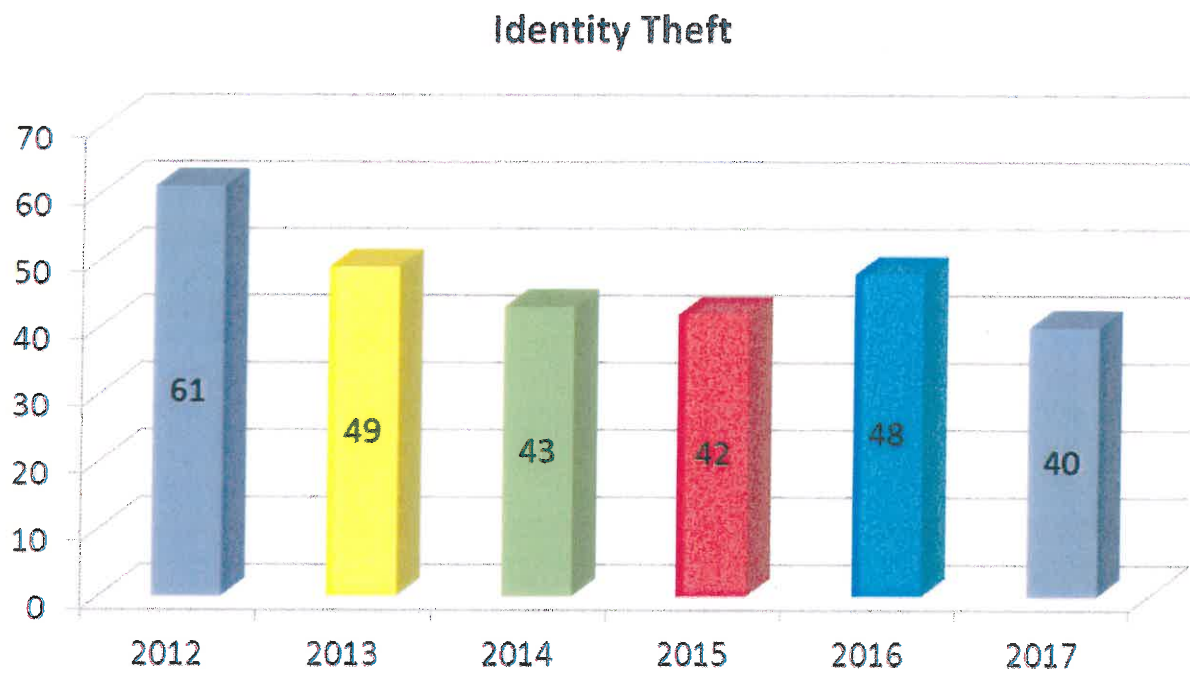
BURGLARY STATISTICS



IDENTITY THEFT / FRAUD:

- Identity Theft is the unlawful use of another person's identity to obtain credit, goods, money etc..
- What we need:
 - Positive Identification on a person committing the crime.
 - Valid Identification, finger print, video surveillance, common customer (photo line-up).
 - Any evidence obtained from the crime (i.e. Copies of credit card, check, false I.D.

ROBBERY:

Robbery - Penal Code 211

- Robbery is the felonious taking of personal property in the possession of another, from his person or immediate presence, and against his will, accomplished by means of force or fear.

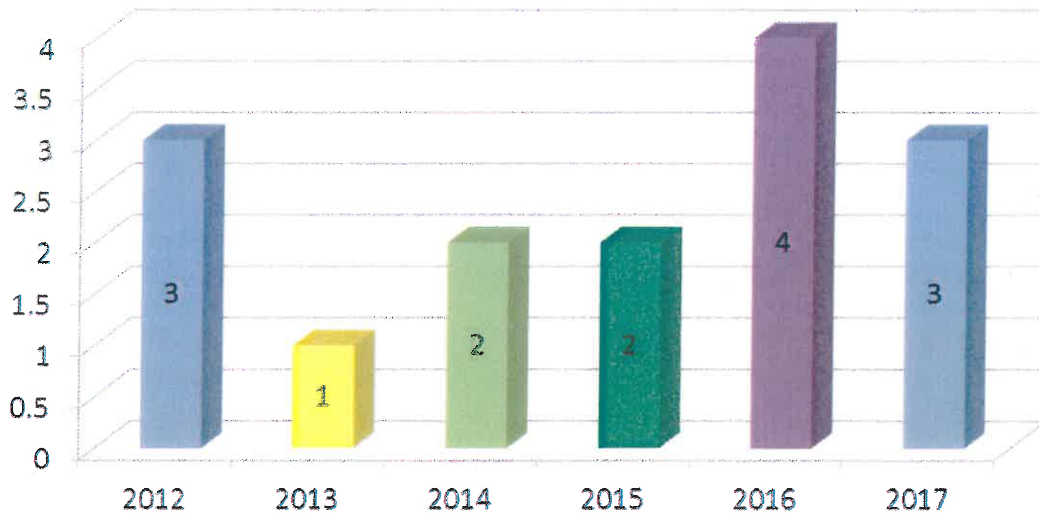
What to Do:
